

ADENOVIRUS "HEPATITIS"

- What is Adenovirus?
 - A viral Infection that causes liver inflammation.
- How do they get infected?
 - Consumption of urine, feces &/or saliva from infected animals.

Infected animals carry disease for 6+ months which sudden death may occur.

- Symptoms:
 - Fever (slight fever -> death)
 - Congestion of the Mucous Membranes
 - Vomiting/Diarrhea
 - Abdominal Pain
 - Deficiency of blood clotting

The virus attacks the Liver, Kidneys, Spleen and Lungs.

Other signs:

- Loss of appetite, inflammation of the eyes "Blue Eye" and nose, Due to the fluid swelling.
- Nose and face appear red and bruised.
 - Due to the fact that the disease is attacking the liver. It is destroying its main clotting factors. When the liver is destroyed they will bleed out with no clotting source. (This is mainly with severe cases)

Vaccines given as a combo with DISTEMPER.
