

BORDETELLA/KENNEL COUGH

- *What is Bordetella/Kennel Cough?*
 - *Bordetella – Bacterial Component of Kennel cough*
 - *Kennel Cough – Viral Infection*
 - *Inflammation of the upper airways. Usually improves on its own. It can progress to fatal bronchopneumonia in puppies or bronchitis in weakened, ill or aged dogs.*
- *How do they get it?*
 - *Spreads rapidly.*
 - *Stress and environment changes*
 - *Extremes of ventilation*
 - *Temperature*
 - *Humidity will increase the pets susceptibility*

Signs :

- *Dry Coughing*
- *Spasms of harsh coughing*
- *Retching or gagging*
- *Fever*
- *Nasal discharge*
- *Depression*
- *Loss of appetite*

Vaccines

Intra Nasal every 6 months

Injectable every year.
